SH—Shuttle

R—Ring

cl—Close

RW—Reverse work

Ch-c—hain

Smp—small picot

J—join

JK—Josephine knot

Ctr—center

IR—inner ring

OR—outer ring

Row 7 \*JK 10, j to ctr p of first single OR ring just before cluster, JK 10, cl. RW

Ch 14 d, 5 p sep by 2d, 14d. RW

JK 10, j to ctr p of 2nd ring of cluster, JK 10, cl. RW

Ch 14d, 5 p sep by 2d, 14d, RW.

JK 10, j to ctr p of next single OR ring, JK 10, cl. RW.

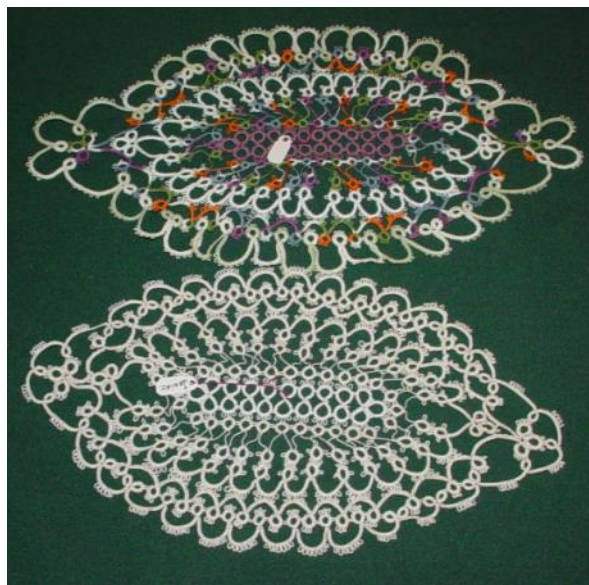
Ch 14d, 5 p sep by 2d, 14d RW.

(R 8d, j to ctr p of next ring, 8d, cl.

R 8d, j to ctr p of next ring, 8d, cl. RW

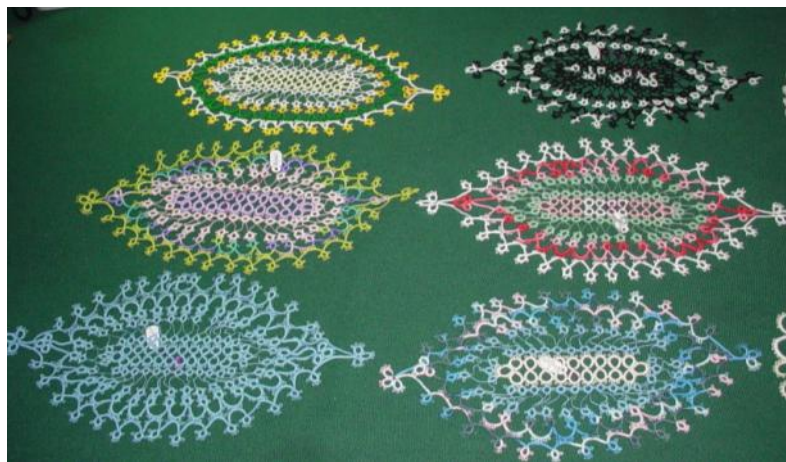
Ch 14d, 5 p sep by 2d, 14d. RW.) 20 times.

Rep from \* around. J to base of first ring. Cut and tie.

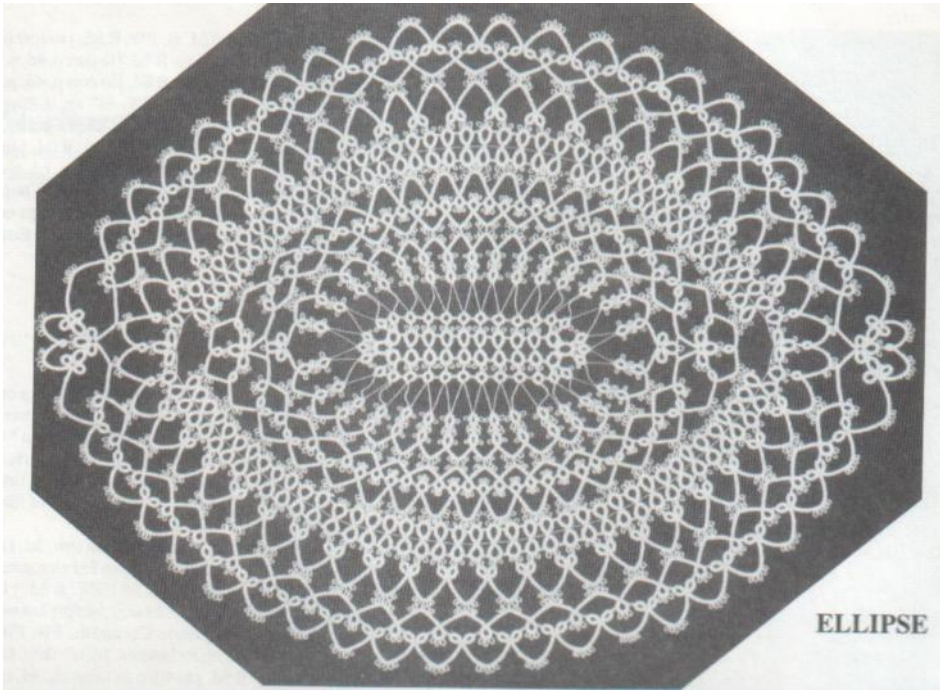

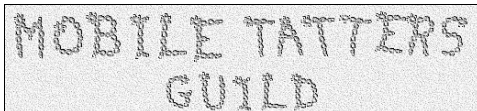
