SH—Shuttle                J—join  
R—Ring                    JK—Josephine knot  
cl—Close                    Ctr—center  
RW—Reverse work        IR—inner ring  
Ch-c—chain                OR—outer ring  
Smp—small picot

2d, p, 10d. RW.

Rep from \* 19 times.

\*\*Rep ring once.

Ch 20d, j to ctr p of next ch, 18d. RW.

3-Ring Cluster—R 14d, p, 4d, cl.

R 4d, j to p, 6d, 3 p sep by 2d, 6d, p, 4d, cl.

R 4d, j to p, 14d, cl, RW.

Ch 18d, j to ctr p of next ch, 20d. RW.

Rep from \* to \*\* around other side. J to base of first ring.  
Cut and tie.

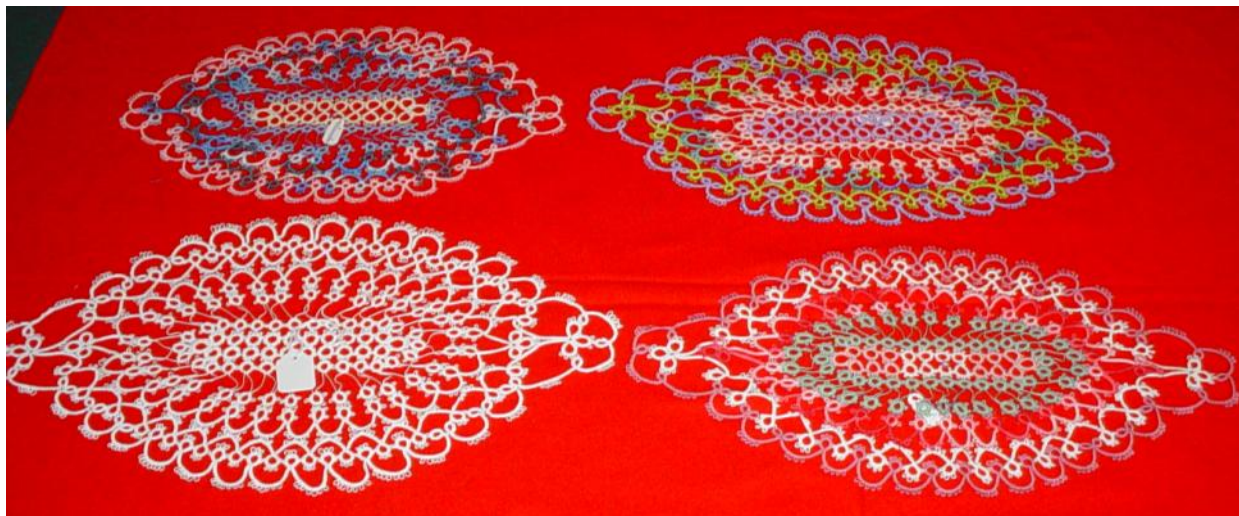
**Row 8:** Starting at end..

\*R 4d, p, 4d, 3 p sep by 2d, 4d, p, 4d, cl. RW.

Ch 10d, p, 2d, p, 2d, j to ctr p on ch bet 3rd JK and double rings, 2d, p, 2d, p, 10d. RW.

\*\*R 4d, p, 4d, 3 p sep by 2d, 4d, p, 4d, cl. RW

Ch 10d, p, 2d, p, 2d, j to ctr p on next ch, 2d, p,



*This is rows 1-5. They are coming along nicely.*

*Here is a sneak peek at row 6. It uses one shuttle only. However, it takes a LOT of thread, prayer and patience.*



## Show and Tell

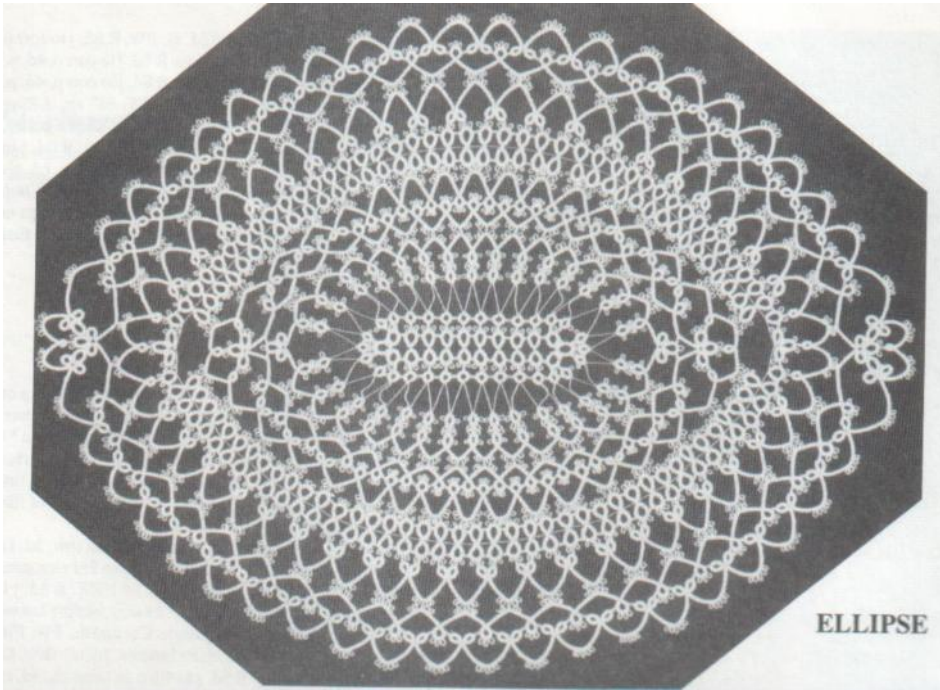

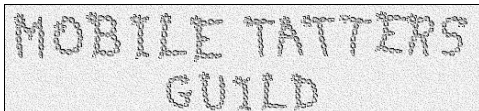
